

## WHAT'S GOING ON?

- The external works continue to progress with the hard and soft landscaping substantially complete to the north and west of the new campus
- The areas to the south of the site are now the focus, along with the new road connections and pathways to the existing carriageway and pavements
- With these new connections, new lighting will be installed outwith the current site boundary
- The external facades are complete to all three of the main blocks with the external stores and the remaining boundary wall currently being completed to the south of the teaching block
- All utilities became live over the second half of the summer
- All internal wall and ceiling finishes, including glazed walls and feature panels, have progressed allowing the final decoration and flooring to continue through the blocks
- The toilet finishes have continued to progress and the main kitchen fit out has commenced
- The installation of the services to all workshops has progressed with the acoustic wall panelling following on from the installation of these substantial works
- The Furniture and Equipment fit out has progressed in various rooms, including the salons and science labs
- The games hall, to the East of the campus, equipment has been installed, along with the lockers to the sports block



Welcome to the tenth community update on our new campus in Falkirk.
