Our lawful basis for using the data is 'public task in the public interest'; we use this information to record the outcomes of your College experience, and to ensure that the Scottish Funding Council and Scottish Government have accurate statistics for educational attainment.

The data being used does not include special category (sensitive) data.

If you were to withhold this data the consequences would be an incomplete return for the Scottish Funding Council, and incomplete data for College planning processes: there would be no consequences for you, as the process is voluntary.
